KIT LIST

Clothing.

Space is at a premium on board so please use <u>small soft bags</u> (i.e holdall) to bring things in. no cases or bags with wheels please.

Clothing and footwear may get muddy and / or dirty

Depending on weather, layers are best as it can be warm when working locks or walking and cold when driving the boat. Bring a change of clothing in case of accidental dunking! Gloves (old ones) hat.

Waterproof

Something to wear for a meal out on Saturday/Sunday night

Suitable non slip footwear e,g trainers for above board and on land (no heels or open toes)

Change of footwear for indoors

Underwear + spare socks

night wear (think "camping" as it may be chilly at night)

washbag

suntan lotion / sun hat / sun glasses / lip balm

hand towel (there is a shower on board so bring a large towel too if you intend to use it)

camera (optional)

own travel mug (optional)

book / magazines

torch

Pillow, sleeping bag or single duvet, blanket and sheet (bring in a bin liner or similar) (again think "camping" as it may be chilly at night or too hot for a duvet)

- there are no plug points and no heating
- This will be an active weekend where you will be outdoors a lot of the time so come dressed appropriately.
